

Playing a role in Malaysia's future

James Thompson III is a true global citizen. Born in Yokohama and raised in Hong Kong, James has spent a large portion of his life in Asia. "My parents are American, they came to Asia in the 1960s and never went back," said James, who spent the last 19 years working in China. Now in Malaysia, he is set to spearhead Crown Worldwide's long-term development in the country.

What specifically brings you to this part of the world?

The level of talent here is good because Malaysians have a global mindset, are well educated, and multi-lingual. They also view the world from an international perspective. Those are qualities that are specific to a multicultural environment with a westernised education system, and that is unique.

What's the single best thing about the RP-T (Resident Pass-Talent) program?

It's an enticing program because being granted a 10-year pass makes it a lot more attractive for me to want to work and stay here. In other countries, it is unheard of for a foreigner to get that sort of duration. To me, this shows that Malaysia genuinely wants to attract foreign talent to come here.

The RP-T enables highly qualified expatriates to continue residing and working in Malaysia for up to ten years. As it is personal to holder, it provides greater flexibility in terms of employment. The RP-T is also extended to spouses and children (below 18 years old) of successful applicants, allowing their spouses to seek employment in Malaysia.

The Crown Worldwide Group was founded by James E. Thompson, James' father, in 1965. The company's Malaysian business has grown from strength to strength in the past 40 years, and is now managed by James.
